

## **GEORGIA INTERNATIONAL HORSE PARK**

### **CREWMAN**

#### **Nature of Work:**

This is semi-skilled and manual work in which some independent judgment is exercised in carrying out duties.

Work involves more than usual physical strength and endurance, and is usually performed under close supervision. Verbal work orders are issued and work is inspected frequently.

#### **Essential Functions and Responsibilities:**

Performs as a member of the construction crew in building fences.

Responds to building maintenance calls.

Operates a dump truck (under 36,000 G.V.W.) when necessary.

Assists in work such as plumbing, electrical and other construction jobs as needed.

Mows lawns with hand powered and riding mowers.

Operates weed eater, chain saw, pressure washer, and other related equipment.

Cleans and maintains GIHP facilities.

Inspects and cares for stalls.

Performs landscaping duties on GIHP grounds.

Performs basic event set-up.

Sets up public address systems.

Shampoos and cleans carpet.

Strips and waxes vinyl composition floors.

Performs related work as required.

#### **Knowledge, Skill and Abilities:**

Knowledge of safety practices and procedures.

Knowledge of public address systems.

Skill in operating power tools and various other tools.

Skill in assembling materials and constructing rough products.

Ability to recognize hazardous waste.

Ability to work around horse and rider with regard to safety.

Ability to interpret verbal and written instructions, and carry them out in an efficient manner.

Ability to communicate using a two (2) way radio.

Ability to perform as part of a crew of workers.

Ability to safely operate light construction equipment.

Ability to work in inclement weather.

Ability to lift a minimum of fifty (50) pounds.

Ability to work in ditches containing up to three (3) feet of water.

Ability to negotiate uneven terrain, unassisted, while carrying objects up to fifty (50) pounds.

Ability to tolerate environments containing dust, dirt, grease, and horse manure and urine.

Ability to climb ladders and withstand heights.

Ability to work in confined spaces.

Ability to maneuver in low-clearance areas.

Ability to operate a standard equipped vehicle.

Ability to work shifts, including weekends, nights and holidays.

**Education and Experience:**

Completion of at least eight (8) years of formal education.

Experience in similar manual work.

Possession of a valid Georgia driver's license, or any license deemed necessary for a specific job.

An equivalent combination of education and experience is acceptable.
